A Note From Pastor Eric

"Be Strong in the Lord!"

In the last chapter of the book of Ephesians, Paul encourages us with these words, "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might." (Ephesians 6:10). Paul is bringing us into the section of putting on the whole armor of God (Ephesians 6:10-18), living a victorious life, a powerful life for Christ. He is talking about the supernatural power of God. And he calls us to be "strong", but not in our own strength, but by the "power" of His might. The Apostle Paul uses the Greek word *kratos* for power. *Kratos* is great word for us as Christians. Dr. Rick Renner writes that *kratos* means "demonstrated power. In other words, *kratos* power is not power that one merely adheres to and believes in intellectually. Rather, this *kratos* power is a power that is demonstrative, eruptive, and tangible...This means that *kratos* power is not hypothetical power; this is real power!"

We are just a few weeks removed from Easter. And the reason I want us to consider this idea of being strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might, is that this is not the first time Paul has used the word *kratos* in the book of Ephesians. Back in the first chapter we read a prayer of Paul for the Church.

"Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know


what is the hope of His calling, what are the of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of His **power** toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty **power** which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come."

-Ephesians 1:15-21

The Apostle Paul uses the word "power" twice in verse 19. The first time it is the word "dynamis" which we get the English word "dynamite" from. But the second time it is the same word from Ephesians 6:10, kratos. But I am struck by the context. Paul encourages us to be strong in the Lord, and he tells us that the same power that God used to raise Jesus from the dead at the Resurrection, that same power is at work in us. Isn't that amazing to think about? As we come through the Easter season, I want each of us to remember what we witnessed at the empty tomb, that extraordinary power of God at work, this is the same power at work in you.

Through the Holy Spirit in us, we are empowered by the Lord. Don't forget about the awe you witnessed on Easter, the ground shook, the veil was torn, the graves were opened, the dead were brought back to life. Jesus is victorious! But remember as you think of Easter that God has not left you powerless. Instead, we are called to be strong in the Lord and the power of His might. That empty tomb is a beautiful reminder of God's power towards you and in you. "Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us." (Romans 8:37). Let the Church be strong in the Lord, everyone of us!
