
One of the definitions in the dictionary of the word "Guilt" is Self-reproach for supposed inadequacy or wrongdoing. Interestingly almost a third of all the times the word appears in the Bible, it is found in the book of Leviticus. It appears in a string of verses that state someone's guilt if they commit a certain act, and then often later in the section, a sacrifice is prescribed to remove that guilt. As we read the Old Testament, we see a picture of guilt being removed by a sacrifice. A person does something wrong; they bring their animal to the altar and it is killed for their sins and they are forgiven.

But then we come to Jesus and He dies on the Cross for our sins. By His blood we are forgiven. And in the Lord's Prayer Jesus teaches us to ask for forgiveness through a simple 5-word prayer, "And forgive us our debts." So simple, yet so many Christians struggle with "Can it really be that simple? Can I really be forgiven?" No sacrifice. No elaborate prayer or action required, just simply asking Jesus to forgive us.

And I think so many Christians, even after repenting, continue to struggle with guilt. In Revelation 12:10, Satan is called the Accuser of the brethren. He is seen several times in Scripture bring accusations against the people of God. And he is crafty (Genesis 3:1, 2 Corinthians 2:11). One of the ways Satan attacks us is before we sin, he seduces us with soothing words, "It is no big deal. Don't worry about it. Everyone is doing it." But then immediately after we sin, he condemns us, saying, "God will never forgive you. You are terrible. Unredeemable."

I think it saddens Jesus that so many of His children are still carrying around the burden of guilt, even though He has forgiven them. Brother Lawerance in his book, "Practicing the Presence of God" writes, "That we ought, without anxiety, to expect pardon of our sins from the blood of Jesus Christ, only endeavoring to love Him with all our hearts." We need to be reminded of the amazing grace we find in Jesus. In 1 John 1:9 we have this promise from God's Word. "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." The Early Church Father, John Chrysostom wrote in his Repentance Liturgy from 4th Century, "Have you sinned? Enter into the Church and wipe away your sin. The number of times you fall down in the marketplace equals the number of times you rise up. Likewise, as many times you sin, repent of your sin; do not become discouraged. And if you sin a second time, repent a second time...enter into the Church and repent, because the Church is a hospital, not a court of justice...Tell your sin to solely God, 'Against you and only you have I sinned, and done evil before you,' and your sin is forgiven."

When the voice of guilt continues to whisper in your ear, hold to the truth of Psalm 103:12, As far as the east is from the west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us." "Seeing their faith, He said, "Friend, your sins are forgiven you." (Luke 5:20).

nutritional meals and school work while also spiritual food and building a connection with families in a community that lead to establishing a church in those communities.

Starting this fiscal year the LBA raised the tithe from the general fund for missions by one/half a percent to twelve and half percent. The mission


committee is looking to support additional missionaries in each of our categories of Wesleyan Global Partners, other global missionaries and Community Missions.


- 1. Please pray for me in this new role and for the Sunday school program in general.
