#### **Mission Impossible**


"He is not here, but is risen!" - Luke 24:6a

Easter this year is on March 31, 2024. We will certainly celebrate this wonderful day. In the world, the celebration of Easter is often associated with Easter baskets, chocolate candy, egg hunts, and bunnies. In the church, Easter is often celebrated with sunrise services, sanctuary decorations, special worship, and a message about the Risen Savior! Easter is a special day. Growing up, my dad who was a pastor, always tried to have a special Easter celebration in his churches, and I have all these fond memories whether it was holding up an umbrella over his head during a rainy sunrise service or eating way to much at a big Easter church breakfast, or the beautiful celebration services. I remember many Easters growing up.

Then as I became a pastor myself, I always, following in his footsteps wanted to make Easter special for the church. I would try to plan out the service weeks, maybe months in advance. I would consider funny videos to make you laugh, reverent videos to make you cry. I would line up special music and holiday choirs. I would plan out a celebration service with readings and prayer time and a moving message to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus.

But it occurs to me, "wait, it is Easter." Do we really need all these things to draw our attention? It is in Easter that we celebrate that Christ is Alive! We hear the words of the angel by the empty tomb, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay (Matthew 28:5b-6)." It is a shining moment of hope and wonder. E.B. White once wrote, "Always be on the lookout for the presence of wonder." As you read the Easter story in the Bible, it is a story of wonder, an amazing story. And each Easter we are invited again to "Come, see the place where the Lord lay." We are reminded that "He is not here; for He is risen." And I believe we need to be reminded of that in the hurried lives we can live.

Both the stories of Christmas and Easter are wrapped in wonder and the impossible. For Christmas it is Gabriel's words, "For with God nothing will be impossible." And at Easter it is the miracle of that stone rolled away to reveal the empty tomb. Author Mark Batterson wrote, "When Jesus walked out of the tomb, the word impossible was removed from our vocabulary." My encouragement to us this Easter season is to pause and just bask in the wonder of Jesus Christ, who He is, and what He has done, and what we truly get to celebrate this Holiday season.

#### **Missions Article**



We have had a very active mission program during the first quarter of 2024. From January 28th to February 3rd we had six men travel to Mayfield Kentucky to work with Samaritan's Purse. Pastor Dan Pickering, Ryan Burns, Doug Brokaw, Lynn Karr, Wes Coots, and Keith Brewster participated building new homes for families which

lost their homes in a large tornado that devastated this community in December of 2022. We had the opportunity in celebrating the dedication of a new home for a family as they

received ownership of this house absolutely debt free. The group was divided and worked on homes that were nearing completion for new residence. We had the blessing of working with SP staff and other teams from other parts of US.



Also from March 1st to March 8th, seven individuals our church were part of a 18 person medical team lead by Dr. Joseph DuPra and Phil Jones to Guatemala. The Buena Vista's members were Cheryl McMahon, Phyllis Haenisch, Cody Reinbold, Peggy Cornell, Steve Conklin, Don Willis, and Keith Brewster. During the week we were in Guatemala the team traveled to three villages to provide medical exams and medicine to the residence. We also provided simplified eye exams and glasses to the attendees of the




clinics. One of the villages had never had a medical clinic there. The fourth clinic was at the Impacto facility in San Juan La Laguna. The team saw a total of 420 patients, 18 of them gave their lives to Christ, and many more seeds were planted.



On January 28, Chris George spoke in both morning services. He and his wife Melissa have been in the states visiting supporting churches as they prepare to return to Australia. They have raised the sufficient financial and prayer support and will be flying back to Australia the 25th to be there for Easter.

On February 25th., Jim Pickett was our guest missionary. He spoke in both morning services, sharing the work he and his wife Karen are involved in the country of Mozambique Ang teaching at the Xai Xai Bible school there. They are also raising support to return to Mozambique this summer. Please pray for Jim and Karen as they are also dealing with the needs of elderly parents and may have to adjust there time in Mozambique with Karen staying in the states with her parents at this time.
